As a Campaign Intern at the age of 18, I oversaw East Suffolk Liberal Democrats tripling their number of councillors and getting into administration, as well as West Suffolk Liberal Democrats winning their first representation onto West Suffolk Council ever.

Since then, I've been the Campaign Manager for West Suffolk, transforming a local party from the brink of collapse to County leading, as well as being Chair of the Suffolk Campaigns Committee, leading on the campaign strategy for the 2025 county council election.
